ORGANIZATIONAL MEETING OF THE PUTNAM COUNTY LEGISLATURE HELD IN THE HISTORIC COURTHOUSE CARMEL, NEW YORK 10512

Tuesday January 6, 2015 7:00 P.M.

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 P.M. by County Clerk Michael Bartolotti who requested that Board of Election Commissioner, Anthony Scannapieco lead in the Pledge of Allegiance. County Clerk Bartolotti then requested Legislator Wright to lead in the Legislative Prayer. Upon roll call, Legislators Scuccimarra, Gouldman, Addonizio, Nacerino, Albano, Gross, Castellano, LoBue and Wright were present. Also present was Legislative Counsel Van Ross.

Item #4 – Appointment/Chair/Putnam County Legislature was called first. County Clerk Bartolotti requested nominations from the floor for Chair of the Legislature.

Legislator Nacerino made a motion to nominate Legislator Albano as Chair; seconded by Legislator Castellano.

Legislator Nacerino stated that Legislator Albano has served this Legislative Body and the people of Putnam County well as Chairman in the year 2014. He is a hard working Legislator with a personal and professional demeanor. His proven leadership style incorporates calmness, fairness and the utmost respect for everyone's perspective and opinions. She stated that it is without reservation that she fully supports Legislator Albano for reappointment as Legislative Chair for 2015.

RESOLVED, that the County Executive and the Putnam County Legislature are in favor of sharing government office space and are desirous of accommodating Senator Sue Serino by permitting her to use the Surplus Office Space as a district office; and be it further

RESOLVED, that such permission shall be on a temporary basis until such time as Senator Sue Serino makes more permanent arrangements concerning the location of her district office, whether that be formally leasing from the County and using said Surplus Office Space at the Center, or acquiring and using other office space elsewhere; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the County Attorney is authorized to prepare the necessary documentation, including drafting a formal lease or Letter Agreement, between Senator Sue Serino and the County confirming the permission granted herein; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the County Executive is authorized to execute such documentation on behalf of the County.

She stated that in the article John Bodor, Captain of the Putnam County Fire Police Response Team, cites the perils he and fellow officers face at scenes of fires and crashes. He asked that every resident of the region to make a special New Year's resolution: "When you observe emergency responders at the scene of a crash or a fire directing traffic or detouring vehicles around the site, please slow down! Remember these men and women did not cause the problem. They are volunteering to safeguard not only the public but the community of emergency responders as well." attentive and careful when approaching an emergency scene. She wished everyone a Happy and Safe New Year.
