ORGANIZATIONAL MEETING OF THE PUTNAM COUNTY LEGISLATURE HELD IN THE HISTORIC COURTHOUSE CARMEL, NEW YORK 10512

Tuesday January 5, 2016 7:00 P.M.

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 P.M. by County Clerk Michael Bartolotti who requested that Board of Election Commissioner, Anthony Scannapieco lead in the Pledge of Allegiance. County Clerk Bartolotti then requested Legislator Wright to lead in the Legislative Prayer. Upon roll call, Legislators Scuccimarra, Gouldman, Addonizio, Nacerino, Albano, Gross, Castellano, LoBue and Wright were present. Also present was Legislative Counsel Van Ross.

Item #4 – Appointment/Chair/Putnam County Legislature was called first. County Clerk Bartolotti requested nominations from the floor for Chair of the Legislature.

Legislator Gouldman made a motion to nominate Legislator Nacerino as Chair; seconded by Legislators Scuccimarra and Wright.

Legislator Gouldman stated that Legislator Nacerino possesses the character traits and qualities to be a true leader. He stated that she served as Deputy Chairwoman of the Putnam County Legislature for the last two (2) years, has been a Legislator for the last three (3) years, has served on the Patterson Town Board for seven (7) years and was on the Patterson Zoning Board of Appeals for six (6) years. He stated that Legislator Nacerino has been a trusted and steady presence and the voice of moderation and reason which he believed were qualities needed for this position.

Legislator Scuccimarra stated that Legislator Nacerino displays a common sense approach when dealing with issues. She stated that, as we don't always agree on all issues, she respected her totally and believed she would make an excellent Chairwoman.

Legislator Gross stated that, we as elected officials are always open to criticism. However he stated that several months ago the Putnam County Courier and Putnam County News & Recorder printed a nasty, tasteless and unprofessional article about one of our colleagues in the Legislature. He believed that the criticism was beyond being unethical journalism. He stated that it is the fiscal responsibility of the Legislators to ask questions about County expenses. He stated that the public needed to know what their taxpayer dollars are being spent on. He stated that the chief reporter of the papers in question, Eric Gross, is the pinnacle integrity. He stated that for that reason alone he would abstain from this vote instead of voting "no."

Legislator Wright stated that he concurred with everything Legislator Gross said regarding the necessity for Legislative inquiry and there ought to be no question that goes unanswered. He stated that if it's of concern to any Legislator, then proper answer to that question should be of concern to every Legislator. However, he stated that journalism in this Country for a long time has been premised on its bifurcated roll. He stated that a newspaper is entitled to have an editorial point of view. He stated that a newspaper is also required to do its job in delivering news and information in a factual way. He stated that our purpose at hand is to deliver important County information and therefore believe we should support this newspaper for its ability to deliver that information to a large spread audience.
