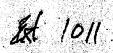

### County Executive and Commissioner:

Further to our conversations in September, I write to formally request a modification of the Village of Cold Spring's proposal for use of ARPA funding from Putnam County. As part of our initial request (and before we knew that the County would be allocating on a per capita basis) our Board of Trustees made a general request toward the repair of our upper dam. On July 5<sup>th</sup>, 2022, via resolution #133, the County Legislature approved a total of \$203,342 for Cold Spring on that basis, drawing 50% from ARPA funding, and 50% from the County's sales tax surplus.

On refinement of the County's own allocation process, the County Executive—rightly—expressed a preference for shovel-ready projects that could be fully or nearly-fully funded with the infusion of ARPA and sales tax surplus from Putnam County. Our dam project is a multimillion-dollar project that requires additional engineering and, likely, multiple funding sources. Therefore, we believe it is prudent to modify the use to which we will dedicate the shared funds.

The Village's water treatment plant needs to have its filters refurbished so we can continue to transform the raw water supply from our dam and other impoundments into safe, finished water for consumption. This need has been discussed for some time. In Spring 2021, when the previous iteration of the Village Board first discussed how to use the direct distribution of the ARPA funds to the Village (\$~200,000), this project was identified as a good option. Our April 2022 ARPA report reflected that consideration. At the time, filter replacement was roughly estimated to be \$360,000,

including parts and labor. Prices have only risen, and we would like to be able to have the new Village Engineer have a fresh look for potential technology improvements. Combining the Village's direct allocation with the shared funding from the County doubles available funds, putting this critical infrastructure project within reach for Cold Spring. Importantly, the County contribution would allow for a proper engineering review and a contingency.

The County Executive's recommendation of this Village request, and the Legislature's approval of it, will benefit Putnam County residents in multiple municipalities. Our water distribution system serves not only the Village of Cold Spring, but also a goodly portion of the Village of Nelsonville and a number of properties in the Town of Philipstown.
